The Adoration and Confession Schedule will continue as normal.

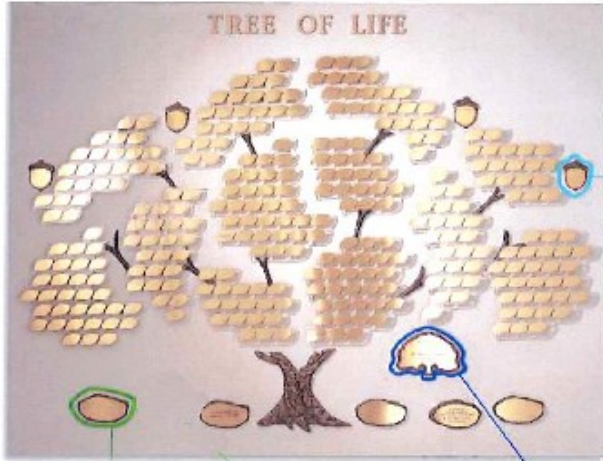
